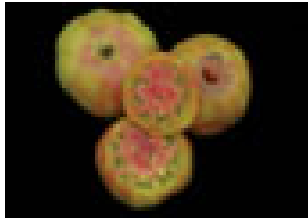


## Euro American Heirloom Tomatoes 2009



**Ananas Noire** This unusual variety was developed by Pascal Moreau, a horticulturist from Belgium. The multi-colored, smooth fruit (green, yellow and purple mix) weigh about 1 1/2 lbs. The flesh is bright green with deep red streaks. superb flavor that is outstanding, being both sweet and smokey with a hint of citrus. The yield is one of the heaviest we have ever seen.



**Aunt Ruby's German Green** 80 days, Indeterminate, HEIRLOOM Beefsteak fruits are 5 to 6 inches in diameter and weigh one pound or more. Sweet juicy flesh, refreshing spicy flavor. Thick green slices are great in sandwiches. Produces fruit in late season and in cooler climates.



**Aussie** 85 days, Indeterminate. HEIRLOOM from Australia. Extra large one to two pound deep red fruit. Growing on large vigorous plants, its flavor is as big as its size. A great blend of sugars and acids makes this a real old fashioned flavored



**Black Cherry** 65 days indeterminate. The first truly black cherry tomato. A perfectly round cherry with classic black tomato flavor, sweet and rich complex. Tall strong vines produce an abundance of fruit. These cherries are irresistibly delicious and a unique addition to the color spectrum.



**Black Zebra** 85 days. Indeterminate. This stunning, perfectly round 1 1/2" to 2" fruits with tender, deep dark red to caramel colored skin beneath vertical dark green and mahogany streaks. Rich flavor with hints of smoke and sweetness.



**Chiquita** 65 days, Indeterminate. A pretty pink grape type cherry tomato. Strong vines produce prolific clusters of sweet, bite sized fruit. Voted in the top 25 in 2001 of the best tasting tomatoes. Steve's dad's favorite.



**Copia** 85 days, indeterminate. Named in honor of Copia, the American Center for Food, Wine and the Arts, in Napa CA. A stabilized cross of Green Zebra and Marvel Stripe. 16oz large tomatoes are visually pretty with fine-lined golden yellow and red stripes.



**Dixie Golden Giant** 85-100 days, Indeterminate. An unusual HEIRLOOM. Grown by an Amish family since the 1930's. Huge, lemon yellow beefsteak-type tomatoes have a delicious, fruity flavor with few seeds. These 1 to 2 pound fruits mature earlier than some others of its type, and may feature a pink blush on the blossom end. Very vigorous vines. Good Yields. Produces fruit through late summer. One of Steve

Goto's favorites for sandwiches.



**Galina's Cherry** 59 Days .Indeterminate Siberia. Arguably our most flavorful tomato. Galina was chosen one of the 10 best early tomatoes by Organic Gardening. Round yellow 1" cherry tomatoes from each vigorous plant. Great cool season yellow cherry variety.



**Green Zebra** 78 days, Indeterminate. The most unusual variety you'll ever grow. Fully ripe fruits are bright green, with stripes of a still lighter green and golden yellow to orange. Round, smallish, 2 to 4 oz fruits have excellent, "real Tomato" flavor. Plants are vigorous, producing good yields. Another of Steve Goto's favorites.



**Hawaiian Pineapple** 90 Days, Indeterminate. HEIRLOOM Beautiful large to extra large yellow beefsteaks. When they ripen they turn to a deep gold and develop red marbling on blossom ends that continue into the flesh. Excellent sweet and fruity. Voted #1 at the 2003 Tomatofest, “Best tasting tomato – overall”



**Isis Candy** 67 days, Indeterminate  
This delightful variety produces yellow-gold cherry tomatoes with red marbling. Marbling varies from just a red blush to extensive streaking inside and out. What is consistent, however, is the sweet taste that is also rich and fruity, and very delicious. Tomatoes are about 3/4 inch across and are round to oblate in shape. Very

productive plants bear throughout a long season. .



**Japanese Trifle Black** 80 days, Indeterminate. Large pear shaped 8oz fruit, produces mahogany-black fruit with green shoulders. Blemish-free and one of the best tasting and pretty black varieties to date.



**Limmony** 80 days, Indeterminate. HEIRLOOMM from Russia. 8 to 10 oz lemon yellow smooth blemish free beefsteak variety. A very clean taste because of its high acid content the flavor seems crisp like a hint lemon. Large fruit set on large plants.



**Momotaro** 78 days. Indeterminate. Full sun. Developed in Japan for its delicious flavored qualities, this light pink fruit has a perfect sugar to acid balance that has produced the best distinctive taste of all the tomatoes produced to date. Vigorous vine produces very high yields. Steve Goto’s favorite overall tomato.



**Neves Azorean Red** 75 days, Indeterminate. A customer born on the island told me about this tomato. I grew it after finding the seeds and found it to be a wonderful 1 to 2 lb red beauty. Huge tomato flavor, this plant is very disease resistant and long bearing.

**Nyagous** 80 days, Indeterminate. Baseball-sized dark brown fruit grow on prolific plants bear up to 6 fruit per cluster. 6oz of firm blemish free fruit with excellent texture and flavor.



**Old German** 75 days. Indeterminate. An Heirloom grown by the Mennonite community of Virginia and one of the best ever for slicing. Huge fruits weigh 1-1/2 to 2 lbs has an unusual boat shape. I selected this tomato for growing after talking to many "Experienced Mature Growers" said this was their favorite. Acidic bite. Excellent for sandwiches.

**Red Pear Italian** 80 days, Indeterminate. Large red pear shaped solid fruit growing up to one pound. No to be mistaken with the cherry type of Red Pear. Great for salads and for cooking and canning. Heavy producing plant produces fruit through a long season. A flavor hit at our 2006 tastings.



**Red Zebra** 85 days Indeterminate. Gorgeous 3in fruit. High yielding great sweet taste extremely uniformed variety with dramatic fire-engine red skins with streaked golden stripes.



**Snow White** 75 days, Indeterminate Ivory-colored cherry tomatoes that ripen to a pale yellow. Fruit is deliciously sweet, round, 1/2-inch and borne from productive vines. This has always been a great hit for me with kids, especially those who claimed to not like tomatoes.



**Sungold Cherry**, 57 days, Indeterminate. Once voted the sweetest tomato ever by discerning English Gardeners. A positively luscious, bite size golden beautiful over-flowing with an abundance of fruits. Thin-skinned, with a juicy flesh that holds its sweet-fresh-from-the-vine flavor. Golden orange, small, round, Very early, and a heavy cropper both indoors and in greenhouses. Cascading trusses are smothered in fruits that remain ripe and ready for picking over long periods of time. Steve Goto say's, this one is a must in your garden. I love these for an afternoon snack right off the vine.



**Sweet Baby Girl** 65 days. Indeterminate The ultimate in super-sweet cherry tomatoes has arrived! The best variety in the world for home growing, with incredible sets of luscious red fruits in long clusters on compact plants. Crack-resistant, bright red fruits weigh less than 1 oz. Apiece, and keep well after harvest. Resists Tobacco Mosaic Virus.



**White Beauty** 85 Days, Indeterminate. Creamy white color inside and outside make White Beauty a rarity. Extremely mild and sweet because of its high sugar content. Fruits average 8oz and are quite meaty with few seeds.



**Zapotec Pink Ribbed** 80 days, Indeterminate. Heirloom tomato from the Zapotec Indians of Mexico, this is a beautiful heavily ribbed dark pink fruit. Its pleated shape makes it very ornamental, and it would be wonderful hollowed and stuffed, or sliced to show off its scalloped edges. The flavor is sweet and mild, and yields are prolific. This is a most unusual variety that is really very pretty.
